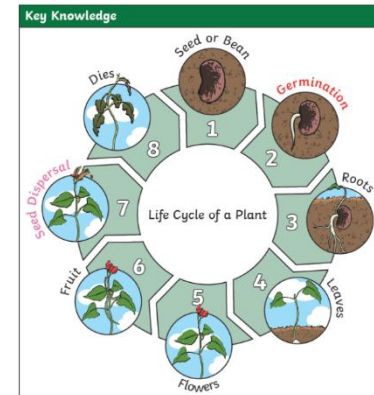
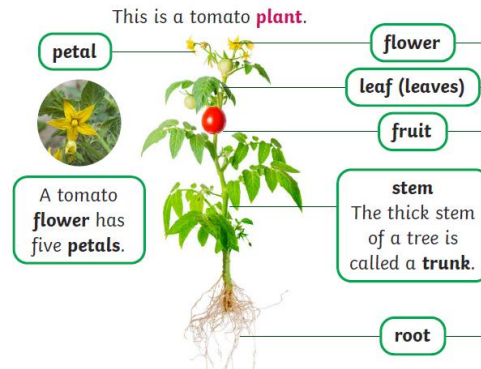
Science

What are plants and how do they grow?

Some plants are wild plants.



Some plants are garden plants.



Key Vocabulary

plant	A plant is a living thing that usually has leaves , a stem and roots.
wild plant	A wild plant is a plant that is not grown by people.
garden plant	A garden plant is a plant that is grown and looked after by people.
weed	A weed is a wild plant that grows in places where people don't want them.

L1 What can we find in a wild garden?	Y1: name common plants using pictures Y2: sort into wild/garden plants and explain choices
L2 What are the parts of a plant?	Y1: label roots, stem, leaves, flower Y2: add simple functions orally or in writing
L3 What do plants need to grow?	Y1: identify needs (water, light) Y2: predict what happens if one need is missing
L4 How do plants grow?	Y1: draw and describe changes Y2: measure height and record in a simple table
