<b>Protestant</b>	A Christian who is a member of the Church of England.
<b>Guy Fawkes</b>	A <b>gunpowder</b> expert who was blamed for the <b>plot</b> .
<b>King James I</b>	The king of England when the <b>Gunpowder Plot</b> took place.

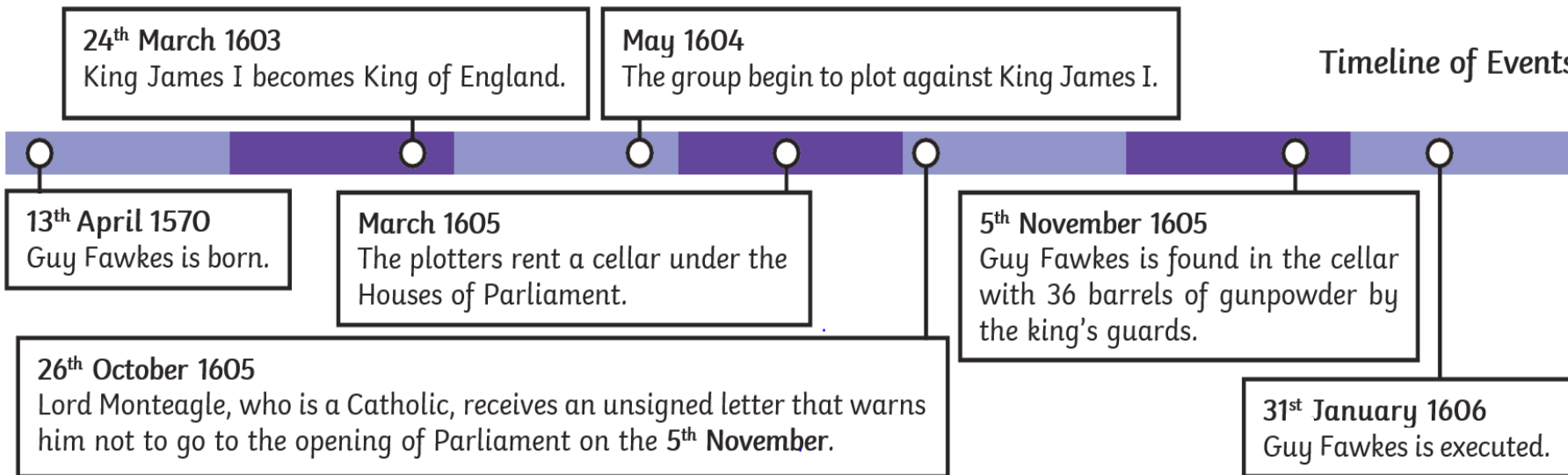

## Timeline of Events





Key knowledge:	
L1- What would Guy Fawkes have used in 1605?	In 1605 they used items including a quill and ink, lanterns, gunpowder barrels and pocket watches.
L2- How did the Gunpowder Plot start?	<p><b>King James I</b> was punishing the <b>Catholics</b>. A group of young <b>Catholic</b> men wanted to stop King James I by blowing up the Houses of Parliament.</p> <p>The plotters were all <b>Catholic</b>. They thought that <b>King James I</b> was being unfair to <b>Catholics</b> because he was a <b>Protestant</b>. They did not want him to be the king any more.</p>
L3- What were the key events of the Gunpowder Plot?	<p>A group of <b>Catholic</b> men planned to blow up the houses of parliament.</p> <p>They hid gunpowder under the houses of parliament.</p> <p>Someone warned the government and <b>Guy Fawkes</b> and the plotters were caught.</p>
L4- What happened to the plotters after the plot was discovered?	<p>Someone warned the government warned and <b>Guy Fawkes</b> was caught in the cellar.</p> <p>Thomas Percy was found on 8<sup>th</sup> November 1605. He was hiding with some of the other plotters, including the leader Robert Catesby. In the battle that followed, both Thomas Percy and Robert Catesby were killed. The other plotters were captured.</p>
L5- What happened in the Gunpowder Plot?	<p><b>King James I</b> was punishing the <b>Catholics</b>.</p> <p>Robert Catesby got some <b>Catholic</b> men together.</p> <p>They hid gunpowder under the houses of parliament.</p> <p>Someone warned the government and <b>Guy Fawkes</b> and the plotters were caught.</p>
L6- How is the Gunpowder Plot remembered?	<p>Remember, remember the fifth of November gunpowder, treason and plot. I see no reason, why gunpowder treason Should ever be forgot.</p>
