<p>1 English – Grammar and punctuation.</p> <p>Write five different lists. These could be things you like doing, things you would like for your birthday, ingredients for your salad, what you would like to do in the Easter holidays and your favourite subjects at school.</p>	<p>2 Topic – DT.</p> <p>Find a recipe to make a salad for your family at home. Take a photo or write your recipe down for the class.</p>	<p>3 Science – Electricity</p> <p>Draw a Venn diagram and find electrical appliances in your house that are battery-powered or mains-powered, or both!</p>
<p>4 Music</p> <p>Learn a song of your choice and feel free to make a recording to show to the class, or even perform it to the class!</p> <p>You could type the lyrics for your home learning book.</p>	<p>5 Maths</p> <p>Find different ways of representing fractions using objects at home.
